An exhibition that was focused on the legacy of Fine Art painting teaching. Although this exhibition was painting focused, because my work has for many years been centred on image development, I was chosen for my contribution to an understanding of the processes behind image generation. In particular my contribution to an understanding of how narrative can be moved from a sequential storyline into a visual simultaneity.

In this exhibition I was represented as one of an older generation of art tutors. I was chosen by Steve Carrick, now Senior Lecturer in Fine Art at the University of Chester, as an important influence on his own practice, he in turn chose one of his students, Samantha Cordery, as someone he would single out that could carry the baton onwards.

Fully Awake is a group exhibition featuring work by over 30 artists that celebrates the intergenerational effects of teaching painting. Curated by Ian Hartshorne and Sean Kaye the show invites several artists to submit a piece of work, as well as invite two 'guest' artists to be presented alongside them; an artist that they have been taught by, and an artist that they have taught. This unorthodox approach creates engaging and surprising relationships between those participating.

Fully Awake is a five part cycle of exhibitions. This is the second iteration, the first being presented at blip blip, Leeds earlier this year. The cycle of shows eschews thematic, aesthetic or theoretical concerns but aims to reveal instead much deeper levels of incidental human, personal, psychological connections and occasional rejections between student and teacher.
